Absolute Transparency Policy At APOKRISIS, we don't hide behind corporate marketing fluff. We believe in absolute transparency with the operators who run our gear. The ITCS and SILENT prototype lines currently deployed are advanced, monolithic structures fabricated from high-temperature polymer matrix composites (PAHT-CF) reinforced with carbon fiber. They are engineered using cutting-edge industrial additive manufacturing parameters to push the absolute limits of thermodynamic signature management.

Because they are lightweight polymer composites and not heavy solid metals, you must understand their operational constraints and lifecycle expectations before pulling the trigger:

- **Intended Duty Cycle:** These composite units are strictly engineered and rated for rimfire (.22 LR), 9mm pistol-caliber carbines (PCCs), and subsonic/bolt-action applications. They are *not* currently rated for sustained, rapid-fire centerfire rifle schedules (like 5.56 NATO or 7.62 NATO).
- **The Operator R&D Loop:** By purchasing an Alpha prototype, you are entering our extended field-testing pipeline. We expect you to train with these units and push them hard within their rated calibers. Minor aesthetic wear, localized carbon discoloration, or internal media erosion are normal parts of a sacrificial transpirational system's lifecycle.
- **Thermal Limits:** While PAHT-CF features exceptional structural rigidity and advanced hoop-stress resistance, polymer matrix elements have structural thresholds under heat. Keep an eye on your firing strings—if the unit becomes excessively hot to the touch during rapid PCC strings, allow it to air-cool to preserve its structural lifespan.

We stand behind our engineering and our word. Your investment in our polymer prototyping phase directly funds our expansion into permanent, aerospace-grade metal sintering.

When our industrial centerfire Direct Metal Laser Sintering (DMLS) Titanium and Inconel active production lines officially go live, every single Alpha polymer buyer has the right to trade in their composite unit.

Under our federal NFA manufacturing authority, APOKRISIS will build your new mirrored metal upgrade and transfer your original registered serial number directly onto the indestructible alloy chassis. This completely bypasses secondary ATF wait times and eliminates the need for a secondary tax stamp, ensuring your asset is secured for life.

The "In Pieces" Policy: We mean what we say about absolute transparency. If you push your carbon-composite prototype past its limits during training and it fails, the guarantee still stands. Even if you have to mail it back to our shop in a bag of broken pieces, we will honor the trade-up.
